## • CARPARK & TRAFFIC - PICK UP/DROP OFF



We are so pleased to be able to welcome all our parents back on site again at pick up and drop off. Please remember there is carparking available at the side of the field and lots of additional parking in the lower carpark.

**Key things to help with the safety in our carparks:**

- There is the ability for 3 cars to park in between each set of trees along the field, please be mindful when parking to help maximize the available parking spaces.
- Please do not park in the drop-off zone, this is only for collecting of students who are waiting.
- Drive slowly. The speed limit is 10km/hr in our school grounds. Please do not speed.
- Do not queue in the driveway. This creates a dangerous traffic queue out onto the road. If you can not find a carpark, please loop round the bottom carpark rather than stopping in the driveway.
- Please do not park along the side of the driveway (along side the hedge). This is a no parking zone.

## • LOST PROPERTY



Please take a moment over the holidays to ensure that all your child/rens items are clearly named/labelled. This ensures that any lost items are able to be claimed and/or returned to their owners. Students are able to find lost property in the basket beside the staffroom.

## • LUNCHBOX LITTER



We are very blessed to have such beautiful grounds at PCS, and it is one of our responsibilities to be caretakers of His creation by reducing our rubbish. We encourage all the lunch-makers out there to try to reduce the wrappers and disposables included in lunchboxes wherever possible and to promote students to be tidy kiwi's and care for our school by packing their uneaten food back into their lunchboxes.

## • SCHOOL DONATION FOR 2022



As you will recall, in 2021 we introduced of an annual donation of \$250 per student to help assist PCS in meeting its financial commitments. As a charitable trust, PCS is able to supplement its income with donations that can be used in other areas of the school. These donations will enable us to enhance the educational opportunities for all our students whilst keeping the fees as affordable as possible. All donations to PCS are eligible for the 33.33% IRD Donations Tax Credit. The 2022 donation is voluntary, so those families who are unable to afford it, must not feel pressured to do so whilst those who can, are able to get the additional benefit of claiming the tax credit. If you are able to donate \$250 (or more) you can do so at any time throughout the school year, donations can also be paid over some months if you would prefer. Donations paid before 31 March 2022 will be eligible for the tax credit in this financial year. Please pay your donations into the main bank account # 03-0406-0616956-000 with the reference 'Donation 2022'. A tax receipt will be provided. Thank you for your continued support as we work together for the benefit of our school.

## • FAMILY ZONE



Cyber safety continues to be in the forefront of our minds the last few months with the increased use of technology. Children are very vulnerable online and as a school, we have partnered with Family Zone allowing us to filter what the students can access on their devices and keeping them safe in the internet world.

PCS will set up a private Family Zone premium account for every family who wishes to support this initiative. The cost is \$20 per family for unlimited devices, (a very special school rate as the independent family cost would usually be \$69/year). All student owned devices that are used in class must have the Family Zone App installed otherwise you have the option to use a school device instead. **This includes all Year 13 student own devices.**

The purpose of the trip was for them to learn how to collect data in these environments as part of learning how to do a Geographical investigation. The class learned how to do a beach profile and how to sample and measure sediment on the beach. At the river, they learned how to measure the cross-section of a riverbed and measure a stream's velocity. It was a wonderful opportunity for the class to learn some important research skills and see Geography in action in the real world!

## • PLUNKET ONLINE BABYSITTING COURSE

Plunket Education in Schools' Babysitting Course is available for teenagers all over Aotearoa.

This course is designed to give high school students the knowledge and skills to babysit children of all ages. It's written for first time babysitters; students don't need to have previous experience to enrol. The course ideal for students aged 14 and above and takes around 2-3 hours to complete. Students work through nine sequential modules and on completion of the course and the final quiz will receive a certificate certified by Whanau Awhina Plunket to show employers that they have completed this course and are ready to babysit. As well as the certificate the students are sent a Babysitter's Manual that supports all the information they have learned in the course.

During the course the following topics are covered:

- the role of the babysitter, including the expectations of the families you are working for
- ages and stages of children from birth to school age, their basic needs and their care
- professional behaviour including your presentation
- how to engage with children of different ages, including activities for each age group and behavioural information
- safety, including emergency situations, keeping yourself and the children safe, and basic first aid
- how to get a babysitting job.

### Here's some tips to ensure you receive notices and push notifications

- When you download the Skool Loop App you will be asked if you would like notifications please **tap yes**. Some devices don't ask this question and automatically tick yes for you. This can be changed in your settings
- If your notifications are turned off in your device settings, some phones apply that to all apps when downloading. In the phone settings please make sure your notifications are turned on
- Check your App Store or Google Play regularly for any outstanding updates
- There are 2 different notices school will send out: **push notification** (banner and ding) or a **notice** (visual alert only)
- You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time
- If your volume is off you will not hear an alert
- You will see a visual alert if a **notice** has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a **push notification**.
